The Zeeland Charter Township Board held a Regular Board meeting on April 5, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall at 6582 Byron Road, Zeeland, Michigan. Members present: Supervisor Nykamp, Treasurer Myaard, Trustees Barkel, Brink, and Oonk. Absent: Clerk Kraak and Trustee Overweg.

Motion made by Trustee Brink to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2016 meeting. Trustee Barkel seconded the motion which passed.

Citizen Participation / Public Comment.

- 1. State Representative Daniella Garcia, 90th District. Rep. Garcia was recently appointed to the Appropriations Committee. She also serves on the Education, Commerce and Trade, Health Policy and Regulatory Reform committees. Ms. Garcia reported Governor Synder recommended a modest 1% growth to the state budget. He also requested 165 million for Flint and 1.25 billion for Detroit Public Schools.
- 2. Tom Brown representing the Trillium Lake Association. Mr. Brown requested assistance from the township to repair a retaining wall. The concrete wall, located along 96th Ave., is beginning to bulge. Mr. Brown asked the board if they could consolidate a drain district to include Trillium Lakes in order to spread the repair costs to a larger group of homeowners. The board took no action.
