

Road Committee Work Session Meeting
March 11, 2014 @ 7:00pm

The Zeeland Charter Township Road Committee held a work session on Tuesday, March 11, 2014. Members present were Chairman Ed Zylstra, Trustee Tim Barkel, John Wittingen, Dave Miller and Earl Mokma. The minutes of the October 22, 2013 were presented for information.

The road budget for 2014 was presented by Chairman Zylstra with the available funds being \$1,413,607.00. A committed paving project is Quincy St w/o 64th Ave with an estimated cost of \$380,000.00. Road projects which were discussed at the October 22, 2013 were again reviewed with one additional road brought up for discussion being Ransom St e/o 64th Ave.

Due to the severe weather conditions this past winter, the committee will again look at the subdivision roads which are on a list from the Ottawa County Road Commission for possible repaving in the near future. Existing asphalt roads are rated by a system called a Paser Rating System as either being good, fair or poor.

Gravel roads were discussed and with the help of the OCRC, the committee will consider their recommendations for re-graveling those roads in need of work. All gravel roads will be included in our yearly dust control application policy.

The five year plan for possible future projects was reviewed for information.

It was brought to the committee's attention that the street identification sign on the corner of 52nd Ave & Riley St is missing. This sign issue has been turned over to the OCRC for replacement.
