- a. Board of Review Report Sixteen appeals were heard and 13 were granted, decreasing total taxable value by \$577,537 and total assessed value by \$833,100. Seven exemptions were granted for disabled veterans.
- Winter Tax Report We currently have \$276,405.26 delinquent taxes outstanding of approximately 4500 parcels. Letters have been sent out for some older delinquent personal property taxes.
- c. The Ottawa County MTA meeting will be held on March 28 in Polkton Township
- d. Drenthe Grove Report Zeeland Recreation's request to use the Drenthe Grove for youth lacrosse, softball and football has been given additional consideration. A plan for a future bathroom is also being evaluated.
