

**ZEELAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 20, 2020**

The Zeeland Charter Township Board held a Regular Board meeting on October 20, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall at 6582 Byron Road, Zeeland, Michigan. Members present: Supervisor Nykamp, Clerk Kraak, Treasurer Veldheer, Trustees Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury. Absent: Overweg.

Supervisor Nykamp called the meeting to order.  
Recited the Pledge of Allegiance.  
Invocation offered by Trustee Salisbury.

Trustee Riemersma motioned to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2020 meeting. Treasurer Veldheer supported the motion which passed.

Public Comment: Al Dannenberg presented Supervisor Nykamp with a Resolution from the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners recognizing his years of service.

Business Items:

- a. Trustee Brink motioned to approve **RESOLUTION #903 3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER 2020 BUDGET AMENDMENT.** Trustee Salisbury seconded the motion which passed unanimously with a roll call vote:

- b. The Fire Committee recommended current Station #1 Lieutenant Brock Bruce for Deputy Chief. Trustee Brink motioned to approve Brock Bruce. Trustee Salisbury seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Committee Reports:

- a. **PLANNING COMMISSION**– Sand mining discussions continued with the Ottawa County Road Commission present. It was tabled until our attorney could review. Went through the sign ordinance. Received cost of tasks and proposal from Main Street.
- b. **FIRE COMMITTEE** – Trustee Riemersma motioned accepting the retirement of Doug Walcott and Paul Formsma with our gratitude for their years of service. Treasurer Veldheer seconded the motion which passed.
- c. **PARKS & RECREATION** – A check was received from Post Hardwood and tree cutting with be scheduled soon. The Drenthe Grove pickle ball court is a little behind schedule because of the busyness of concrete contractors. They are still trying to get it done this fall.
