1. PUBLIC HEARING - An application from Bluff Ridge Properties, LLC for an amendment to the preliminary plat approval of Bluff Lakes No. 5. This property consists of one parcel located on the east side of 96th Avenue, south of I-196. Parcel 70-17-30-300-024 has approximately 18.8 acres of land area. The Applicant is asking for a reduction in minimum side yard setbacks from 15 feet to 10 feet to be consistent with the existing phases of the development.

Access for four lots would be off the private drive. First lot has enough road frontage on New Holland St. for access. Septic and Well have been approved by County Health Dept. Driveway agreement has been submitted. Still need driveway permit from OCRC.

Motion made by Nelson, supported by Russcher to approve the site plan as presented pending approval from the Ottawa County Road Commission for the driveway permit. **Motion carried.**

3. Zoning Amendment Reviews
Review of amendments to Sec. 15.05, Sec. 13.07, Sec. 2.07 and Sec. 3.24 of the Zoning
Ordinances. Public hearings will be scheduled in the next month or two after the
Township attorney has time to review.
