

**ZEELAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
January 17, 2023**

The Zeeland Charter Township Board held a Regular Board meeting on January 17, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall at 6582 Byron Road, Zeeland, Michigan. Members present: Supervisor Oonk, Clerk Kraak, Treasurer Veldheer, Trustees Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.

Supervisor Oonk called the meeting to order.
Recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
Invocation offered by Tom Oonk.

Trustee Riemersma motioned to approve the minutes of the January 3, 2023 Board Meeting. Treasurer Veldheer supported the motion which passed.

Citizen Participation/Public Comment: Ottawa County Commissioner Jacob Bonnema asked for input on how ARPA funds could be used.

Business Items:

- a. Opened public hearing for PA-198 request for By-Pas International Corporation. By-Pas is a manufacturer of cleaning and deodorizing products. They added a 6,764 square foot expansion to create a new space for storing, shipping and receiving goods at a cost of \$1,176,888. Trustee Brink motioned to close the public hearing. Trustee Salisbury supported the motion which passed.
- b. Treasurer Veldheer motioned to approve **RESOLUTION #950 INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES EXEMPTION – BY-PAS INTERNATIONAL**. Trustee Riemersma seconded the motion which passed unanimously with a roll call vote:
AYES: Oonk, Kraak, Veldheer, Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.
- c. Trustee Bosma motioned to approve 2023 subdivision resurfacing with an estimated cost of \$410,960. Trustee Salisbury seconded the motion which passed with a roll call vote:
AYES: Oonk, Kraak, Veldheer, Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.
- d. Trustee Salisbury motioned to approve **RESOLUTION #951 ADOPTING NEW WATER SYSTEM CHARGE**. Treasurer Veldheer seconded the motion which passed unanimously with a roll call vote:
AYES: Oonk, Kraak, Veldheer, Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.
- e. Approval of the Adams Street Boardwalk Rehabilitation has been tabled until the next meeting.
- f. Trustee Brink motioned to approve the purchase of a replacement floor scrubber for Drenthe Grove for \$8100 through Miner Supply. Treasurer Veldheer seconded the motion which passed with a roll call vote:
AYES: Oonk, Kraak, Veldheer, Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.

Committee Reports:

- a. **PLANNING COMMISSION** – Currently looking at amendments to the Agricultural District, Private Road and Site Condominiums ordinances.

- b. **PARKS & RECREATION** – Went over the playground equipment replacement at the Drenthe Grove and are looking into clarification on if any trees would be removed.

Supervisor Report: Will be talking to Attorney Bultje regarding a possible Jake brake ordinance. The MTA conference will take place April 17-20.
