ZEELAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING March 21, 2023

The Zeeland Charter Township Board held a Regular Board meeting on March 21, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall at 6582 Byron Road, Zeeland, Michigan. Members present: Supervisor Oonk, Clerk Kraak, Treasurer Veldheer, Trustees Brink, Riemersma, Salisbury and Bosma.

Supervisor Oonk called the meeting to order. Recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation offered by Trustee Brink.

Four candidates will be interviewed next week for the two open lieutenant positions.
