JUNE 1 DEADLINE FOR SUMMER P.R.E. EXEMPTION

If you purchased a home after Nov. 1, 2023 you should check if you are receiving this exemption. Residents claiming 100% P.R.E. are exempt from paying 18 mills on their tax bill for Hudsonville and Zeeland Schools Operating budget. Call the office or go to our website: zeelandtwp.org.

If you do not receive a tax bill, please call the office to verify your mailing address. Farmers wishing to defer their summer tax payment until winter need to complete a form for each parcel number every year. Forms are available in the office and must be submitted by Sept. 16.

The Assessor's office will be out in the community again this year visiting another 20% of our properties, as the State Tax Commission recommends this be done on an annual basis. They will also continue making appraisal visits at all of the building permits that are issued through the township.

WHAT'S NEW...

ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

MDOT is investing approximately \$17 million to rebuild 4.5 miles of east-bound and westbound I-196 Business Loop (BL) from US-31 in Holland to 88th Avenue in Zeeland. Work includes asphalt resurfacing, full-depth concrete joint repairs, new signs, traffic signal work, crosswalk safety improvements, and new guardrail.

Traffic impacts

- Eastbound I-196 BL will be closed and detoured from April to August.
- Westbound I-196 BL will close from August to November.
- Traffic will be detoured to 16th Street/Adams Street.
- Short-term closures will be in effect on side streets during intersection reconstruction.
- Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

EMERGENCY SIREN INSTALLATION

The Township has recently completed installation of two new emergency sirens on Pleasant St. and 76th Ave. & Perry Street. These new sirens are in addition to the current sirens located at the Public Safety Building on Byron Rd., Fire Station #2 in Beaverdam, and the Drenthe Grove. The township now has sirens covering the majority of our residential areas. Siren tests are conducted the first Friday of the month at 12:00 pm, April through October.

If you've driven by or stopped in at the Town Hall you've noticed we've been getting a facelift. The last few months we have been working to create a secure entrance, refresh the paint and floors, as well as install new office furniture to meet our changing needs. Stop by and check it out!

If you're interested in becoming an election worker, please stop by the office for an application. We'd love to talk to you.

As a result the 2022 election law changes you may now request to be put on the permanent ballot list. Once on the list, you will receive an absentee ballot by mail for ALL future elections. If you plan to be absent from your residential address during the time your ballot will arrive, please call the township clerk to supply your temporary address. Election mail is not forwarded by the post office.

If you no longer wish to receive to automatically receive an absentee ballot by mail, please contact the township clerk to be removed from the permanent ballot list.

PARKS & RECREATION

Van Zoeren Woods - This 34 acre parcel of land lies along side of the Expressway at the corner of 56th Ave. & Riley St. The park has crushed aggregate walking paths, several benches & picnic tables, and a portable restroom to enhance your experience at the woods.

The Township Board recently approved the addition of two wooden pathways over the ravines in Van Zoeren, which will be installed this Spring.

SPRINGTIME SAFETY MAINTENANCE REQUEST

Fire Chief Bruce recommends springtime as a great time to trim trees and landscaping that could hinder fire apparatus from reaching your home. Ensure that your house number is easily visible from the road. If you would like a green reflective address sign they are available from the township for \$20. Inside your home; change the batteries in your smoke detectors.

OPEN BURNING PERMIT

Open burning is regulated by ordinance in Zeeland Charter Township. Generally speaking, the following types of burning are allowed without a permit, provided no nuisance is created:

- Campfires and cooking fires;
- Salamanders and other construction heaters;
- Burning barrel fires

There are certain restrictions, so it is wise to check the Burning Ordinance for details.

For most other types of burning, a permit is required. Permit should be requested at least 24 hours in advance by calling 616-886-6666 (If you don't get an answer, please leave a message).
