

**ZEELAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP**  
**ROAD COMMITTEE MEETING**  
**FEBRUARY 13, 2020**

The Zeeland Charter Township Road Committee held a meeting on February 13, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall at 6582 Byron Road, Zeeland, Michigan.

Members present: Chairman Melissa Veldheer, Supervisor Glenn Nykamp, Trustee Chad Overweg, and committee members Earl Mokma, John Wittingen, and Dave Miller.

Chairman Veldheer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Review of 2018 Road Committee minutes. Motion made by Committee member Mokma to accept the minutes as submitted. Committee member Wittingen supported the motion which passed unanimously.

Citizen Comments: *none.*

Update and current status of Road Fund.

Road Project considerations for 2020:

- a. Riley Street from 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue—re-gravel and chip/seal. Potential ditch work to be done for drainage concerns. Committee member Miller *motioned* and *supported* by Committee member Mokma. *Motion passed unanimously.*
- b. 80<sup>th</sup> Street from Felch to Chicago Drive. Improvement project was *tabled* pending future construction and development on street.
- c. New Holland (gravel portion) Street. Project was *tabled* due to Blendon Township responsibility and pending their decision for improvements.
- d. 52<sup>nd</sup> Avenue north of Riley Street (1/2 mile). Possible road improvement was *tabled* pending pricing limit from Ottawa County on upgrades.

Paving projects:

- a. Drenthe Grove subdivision (Community Ln, Groveside Dr, Midgrove Dr, Settlement Ln)—after construction is completed.
- b. Walnut Creek subdivision (78<sup>th</sup> Ave, Creek Run, Walnut Trl); Crestline Drive, Fairview Lane, Summit Court; and Dover Ln, N. Maple Ct, S. Maple Ct and W. Maple Ct. *Motion* made by Committee member Mokma and *supported* by Committee member Wittingen. *Motion passed unanimously.*

Review of 6 year Road Improvement Plan

- a. Township will inquire with Ottawa County on age of township streets and limits on re-graveling roads within township per year.

Other Business

- a. Letter from Overisel Township was considered. *Motion* made by Committee member Mokma to decline the proposal and *supported* by Chairman Veldheer. *Motion passed unanimously.*
